

NOTICE OF RACE

Event: International Moth Open Meeting Date: 11th / 12th October 2014

- 1. Racing governed by the rules as defined in the current Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) and the Sailing Instructions for the event.
- 2. 6 race series. One race is required to be completed to constitute a series. If four or more races are completed a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score. If less than four races are completed a boat's series score will be the total of her event scores.

3. SCHEDULE

The club will be open from 09:00. Registration will begin at 10:00 on the first day of racing. The competitors briefing will be at 11:30 in the clubhouse. Racing will take place as follows:

- 4. Racing will be on a windward/leeward course and will be outlined in the Sailing Instructions or on the Official Notice Board. The Race area will be advised at the competitor briefing.
- 5. All visitors must sign a clean boat declaration stating: "I confirm that, to the best of my knowledge and understanding, my craft and equipment are clean and free from pollution and non-native invasive species. I understand that my boat and equipment should be washed before returning to my home waters as a matter of good practise." For people who cannot sign this declaration, a washing down point is provided in front of the club house.
- 6. Sailing instructions will be available at registration and also displayed on the open meeting notice board outside the clubhouse.
- 7. Entry fee £40 per boat to include Saturday evening dinner.
- 8. Food available throughout the day from 09:15am. Bar open 5pm Saturday. Dinner served 6pm on Saturday followed by video de-brief in the Club lounge.
- 9. Prize giving ASAP after final race.
